

# Investing for Success

**Under this agreement for 2021  
Chelona State School will receive**

**\$38,000\***

## This funding will be used to

- Ensure 90% of Year 3 students achieve a minimum "C" standard in Literacy.
- Increase the percentage of students in Year 3 achieving A-C data in English from 45% to 90%.
- In NAPLAN, increase the percentage of students from Prep – Year 6 achieving in the upper two bands.
- Develop individual learning plans for students who are below the National Minimum Standard (NMS) or not achieving a "C" or higher.
- Improve the pedagogical practices of all teachers and teacher aides with the teaching of writing to ensure every child receives their curriculum entitlement in order to optimise their individual achievement.

## Our initiatives include

- Fully implementing a Phonemic Awareness Program across the school utilizing researched based material.
- Employing a Head of Curriculum to support the principal to ensure all staff are providing quality learning opportunities for all students.
- Implementing a full Reading Recovery program for struggling readers and writers.
- Triangulating and analysing data in order to improve problems of practice and increase outcomes for all students.
- Providing visible learning strategies in the classroom in English to enable students to identify the unit content and assessment criteria.
- Closely monitoring student progress through classroom observations, running records, writing samples, summative tasks using the P-10 Literacy Continuum.
- Building teacher capability to deliver effective teaching pedagogies with a focus on the P-6 Curriculum.
- Implementing the 'Marker Student' methodology to ensure all students receive their curriculum entitlement.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Purchasing Heggerty's Phonemic Awareness Program and ensure every staff member has the opportunity to engage in the Heggerty professional development	\$2,000
• Employing a part time teacher in order for the principal to implement Reading Recovery with four students per term.	\$18,000
• Employing a Head of Curriculum.	\$18,000
